

The project « Együtt a határok és vámok nélküli Európában » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project involved 246 citizens, notably 70 participants from Subotica (**Serbia**), 43 participants from Százhalombatta (**Hungary**), 43 participants from Kiskunhalas (**Hungary**), 23 participants from Tirgu Mures (**Romania**, 26 participants from Riga (**Latvia**), 41 participants from Zemne (**Slovakia**).

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Subotica (Serbia), from 22/08/2017 to 24/08/2017

Short description:

The day of 22/08/2017 was dedicated to the PROJECT OPENING MEETING where they received appropriate information on the technical details of the three-day event.

The day of 23/08/2017 was dedicated to a conference where attended by representatives of the European Union, customs and legal and trade experts from different countries, as well as practicing economists. Specialized secondary and university students were involved, too. The aim was to discuss the acquis communautaire on the EU market, Serbia's regulation and the possibilities of cooperation that exist before accession. After that there was a WORKSHOP about FREE FLOW, at that workshop, participants got to know and understood the legal, commercial and practical application of the European Union's 4 principles both from a regulatory and a practical point of view.

Day 24/08/2017 was devoted to WORKSHOP about FREE FLOW OF SERVICES, participants had opportunity to get to know and understand the four principles both from a regulatory and a practical point of view.

Every day the playhouse was organized in Subotica's main square.
