

The project Together for a common Europe was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"

Participation: The project involved **328** citizens, notably 164 participants from the Ravnica Udruzenje za Uzgoj Svinja Rase Mangulica Vojvodine (**Serbia**), 12 participants from Skab (**Latvia**), 36 participants from Fundatia Diaspora (**Romania**), 36 participants from Madarsko kulturno drustvo Nepkor (**Croatia**), 18 participants from ECCLESIA ZDRUZENIE (**Slovakia**), 18 participants from OBCIANSKE ZDRUZENIE OAZA KOMOCA (**Slovakia**) and 44 participants from KISKUNHALAS VAROS ONKORMANYZATA (**Hungary**).

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Subotica, Serbia, from 18/06/2021 to 20/06/2021

Short description:

The day of 18/06/2021 was dedicated to Opening meeting.

The day of 19/06/2021 was dedicated to Workshops and Brainstorming.

The day of 20/06/2021 was dedicated to Interactive presentation and Exhibition.

Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.2 "Networks of Towns"

5 events have been carried out within this project:

Event 1

Location / Dates: The event took place in Subotica, Serbia, from 18/06/2021 to 18/06/2021

Short description: The meeting began with a kick-off introductory evening, in the main tent, where participants briefly introduced themselves and then discussed the work plan for the coming days. On the opening event, each partner was attended by representatives of each citizen and organization briefly said what they are doing. The schedule of the next day's workshops was also discussed here.

Event 2

Location / Dates: The event took place in Subotica, Serbia, from 19/06/2021 to 19/06/2021

Short description: Workshops were held in three tents on each of the key elements of the topic:

- Experience of pre-accession processes of countries that joined 16 years ago,
- The last 16 years of experience of integration in terms of civic engagement and euro skepticism,
- The consequences of Brexit and any subsequent exits from the view of full integration.

In these workshops, the representatives of each delegation briefly presented their own practices and then there was a discussion on their effects and their possible transfer to other regions, in order to develop each national good practice into an EU acquis.

Event 3

Location / Dates: The event took place in Subotica, Serbia, from 19/06/2021 to 19/06/2021

Short description: In the afternoon, we had a huge brainstorming session with participants, where the leaders of each workshop reported on their own morning work and then work together on plans that may be appropriate at EU level to maintain and prosper integration. There is a common plan based on EU solidarity and a process that can be used by each partner in its own environment, drawing on the experience of the other partners.

This plan is an excellent opportunity for European partners to solve the problems that arise in their own region.

Event 4

Location / Dates: The event took place in Subotica, Serbia, from 18/06/2021 to 20/06/2021

Short description: Even before the meeting, we ask our partners to produce one of the most interesting material on their topic using one of today's technologies (film, vlog, interactive presentation, etc.). These were also presented in the big tent so that as many people as possible can see primarily local citizens.

Event 5

Location / Dates: The event took place in Subotica, Serbia, from 18/06/2021 to 20/06/2021

Short description: In Subotica a village of solidarity from tents was built, with the help of local and partner NGOs, within three days we planned to achieve the goal by presenting local products and related workshops, which was nothing but European traditions. The partners and the citizens of Serbia got to know each other, a system of contacts was formed between them, which can be easily overcome with today's modern means of telecommunications, so long-term networks can be formed. Each participant learned about the good practices, that already exist in Europe so that they can adopt them and implement them effectively in their own environment.
